



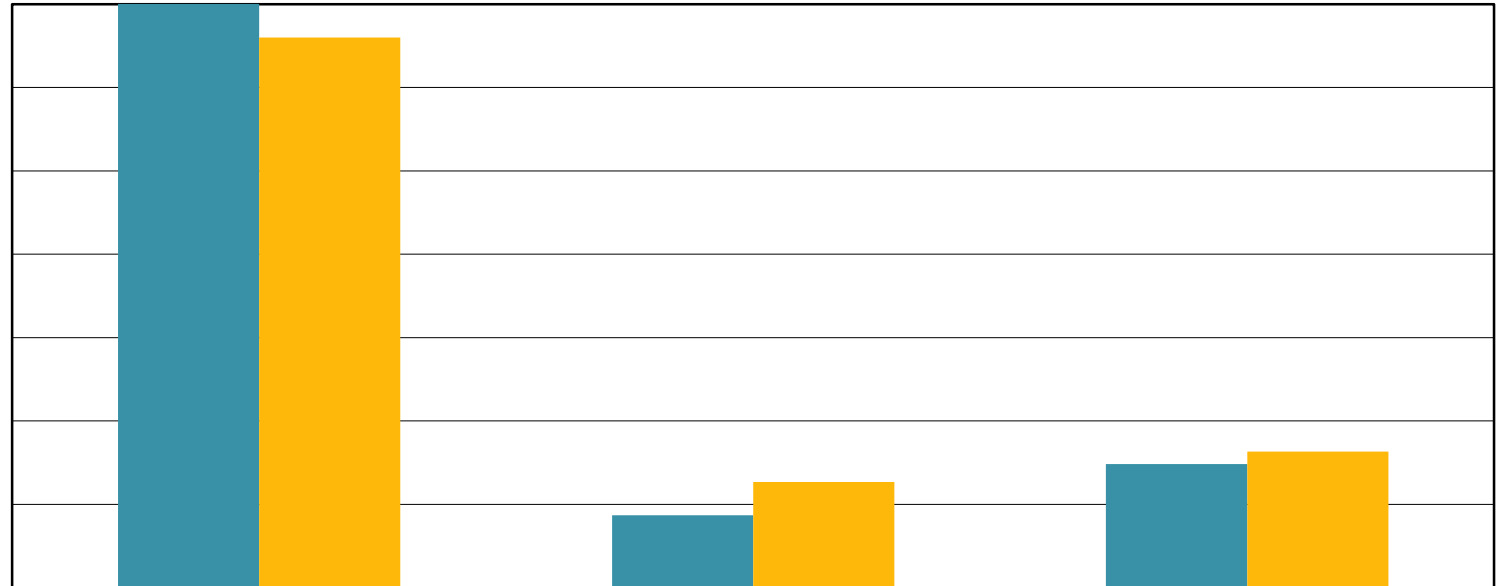

 - Demographics & Enrollments excludes *most* ISA's (except THEA)

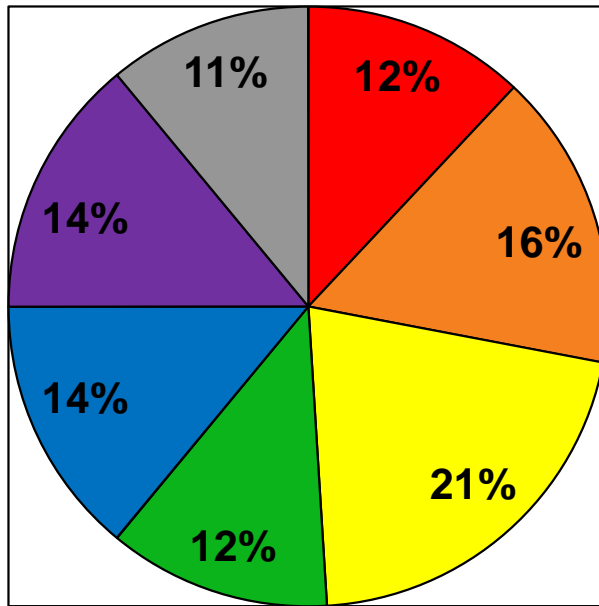

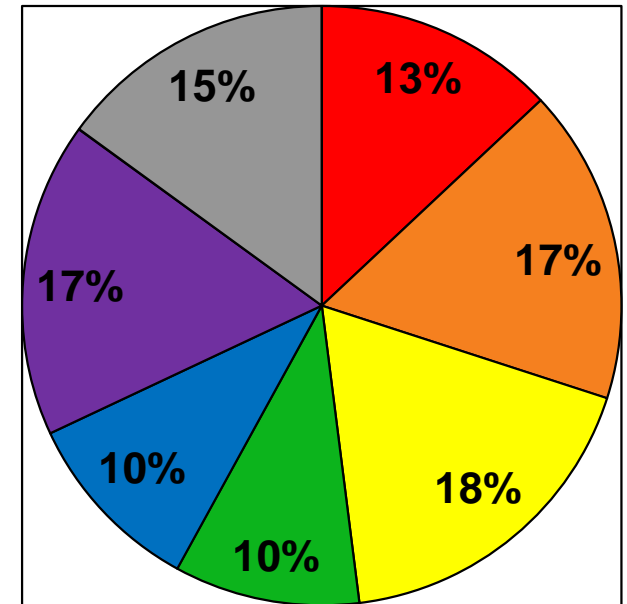

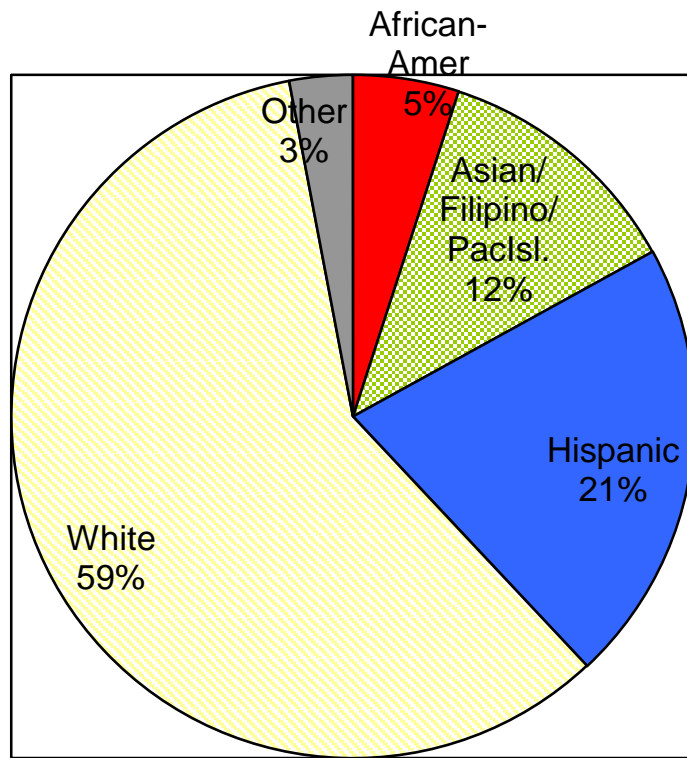

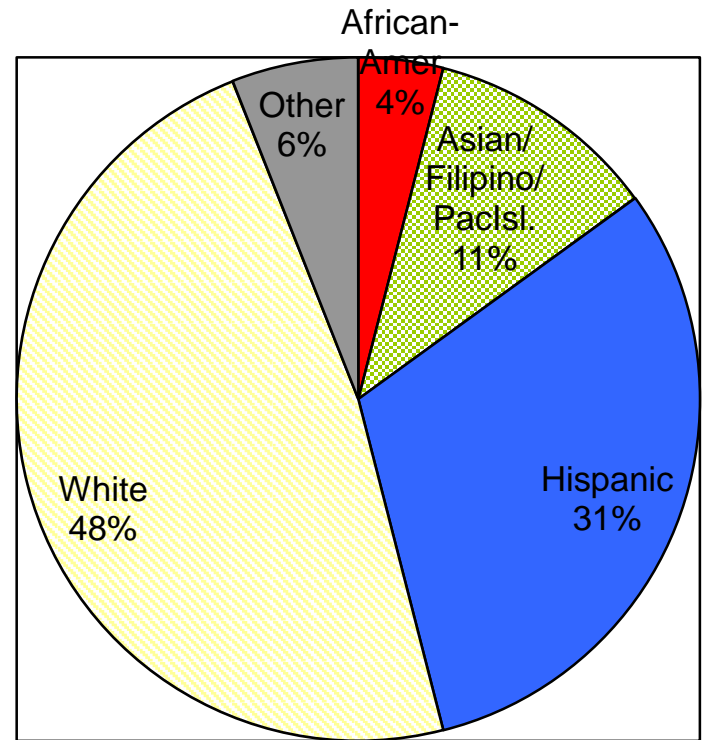


Ethnicity of Students – Then & Now

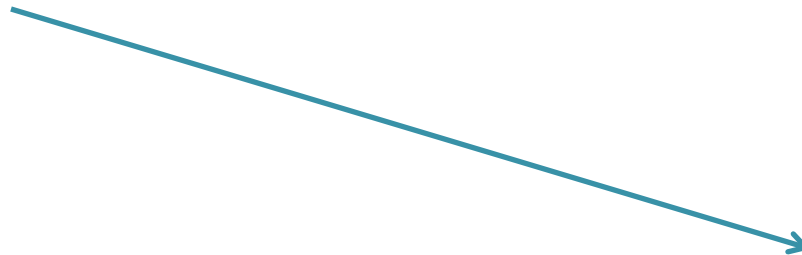

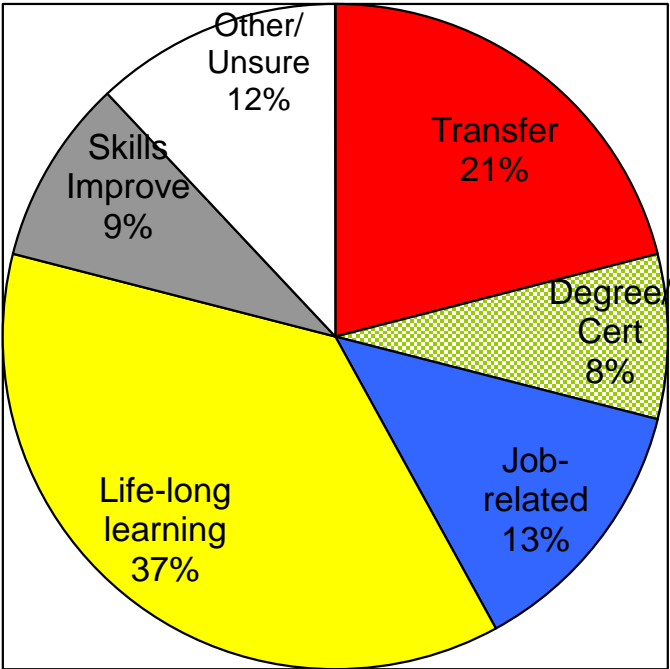

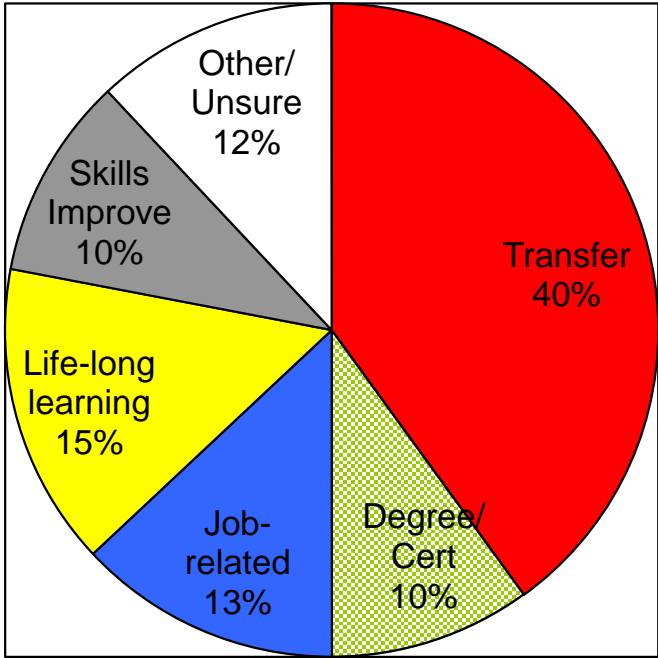


Educational Goals of Students – Then & Now

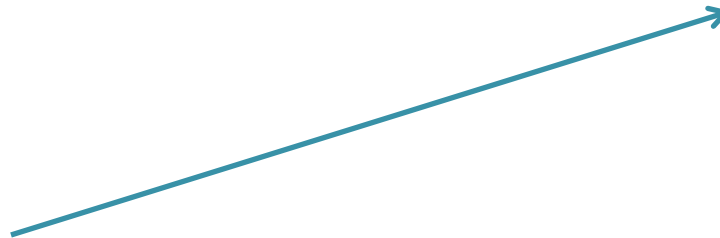
Basic Skills Enrollments – Then & Now
