- ⇒ Student completes the 2015-16 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at www.fafsa.gov.
- ⇒ Pass a credit check conducted by the loan servicing agency. A PLUS applicant who is determined to have an adverse credit history may receive the loan if he or she obtains a co-signer for the loan who passes the credit check.

Application Process:

- 1. Submit a 2015-16 PLUS Loan Application to the MPC Student Financial Services Office.
- 2. Go to . <u>www.studentloans.gov</u>. Select the **Parent Borrowers** box and log in. Then click on "Request a Direct PLUS Loan" and "Complete a MPN". Follow the instructions provided on the website.
- 3. Interest for the 2015/2016 academic year 6.84%. A 4.292% origination fee will be deducted.
