Assembly Bill 13 ("AB 13") requires individuals be granted an exemption from nonresident fees so long as they meet "covered individual" requirements **and** qualify to use Montgomery GI Bill-Active Duty or Post 9/11 GI Bill education benefits (Chapters 30 and 33) **while living in California**.
