




What are the "gatekeeper" courses?




## Let's look at this for a specific course:

ENGL 111	Achieved Completion outcome within 6 years
Passed ENGL 111	66%
Did not pass	22%



## Grades are important:

- (As shown on previous slide), 66% of students who passed ENGL 111 achieved Completion outcome
  - 79% of "A" students achieved Completion outcome
  - 58% of "B" students achieved Completion outcome
  - 41% of "C" students achieved Completion outcome



# Today's "take-away":

Succeeding in the <u>first year of college</u> is very important!

 Basic Skills English and Math courses appear to be "gatekeeper" courses
