- California Community College Chancellor's Office
 Online Education Initiative (OEI)
 - Funded by the legislature in 2013
 - Overall focus is to:
 - help facilitate access to online courses throughout the state
 - provide support to increase success and retention in online courses
 - increase associate degree completion and transfer
 - Participation in the OEI may bring new FTES

 - Orientation






Online Education Initiative results include:

Online Education Initiative results include:

- "Common Course Management System"
 - June 2015 Announced the selection of the Canvas CMS provided by Instructure
 - Negotiated a contract to cover Canvas CMS cost for any college through 2019
 - MPC has the opportunity to decide to adopt Canvas or continue to use Moodle

What is Canvas?

- A Course Management System (CMS)
- Made by Instructure (founded in 2008)
- Canvas product launched in 2011
- Incorporates Web 2.0-like tools
- Used by ~1600 schools and universities worldwide



Why are we evaluating Canvas?

- Chosen as the Online Education Initiative's "Common Course Management System"
- Has been adopted by 21 California Community Colleges
- Provides MPC with an opportunity to evaluate how it is currently delivering online courses

Do we have to switch to Canvas?

- NO! It is entirely up to MPC to decide if Canvas is right for our college
- However, if we participate in the OEI course exchange then any course we teach through the exchange must be taught in Canvas

Is decision already made?

- NO! We are just beginning the evaluation process and will take our time
- Spring 2014 MPC Academic Senate tasked the ICDE to conduct an evaluation
- Fall 2015 ICDE begins evaluation process
- Spring 2016 ICDE will bring a recommendation back to Academic Senate for review and action

As recommended by the Online Education Initiative (OEI) and Academic Senate for California Community Colleges (ASCCC), MPC will rely on faculty expertise as well as student, support staff, administration, technology staff, and research to make a final decision.

What happens to my course(s)?

- Canvas can import Moodle courses
- The OEI has <u>created a guide</u> for Moodle users
- We are currently testing the Moodle to Canvas migration and so far ...
 - Some things transfer seamlessly
 - Some things get a little messy
 - Some things don't transfer at all
- We are looking into all options for course transfer as part of the evaluation

What kind of support will we have?


- The DE team is currently getting up to speed with the Canvas LMS
 - Participating in online training
 - Attending train-the-trainer training
- @ONE now offers Canvas training
- The OEI will provide first-tier technical support for colleges that use Canvas

What are our next steps?

- ICDE is developing evaluation criteria
- Five MPC faculty will use Canvas this spring as part of the OEI pilot
- The campus will be invited to see vendor demonstrations
- We will conduct focus groups and surveys of faculty and students
- We will provide updates through the Canvas evaluation website www.mpc.edu/canvas
