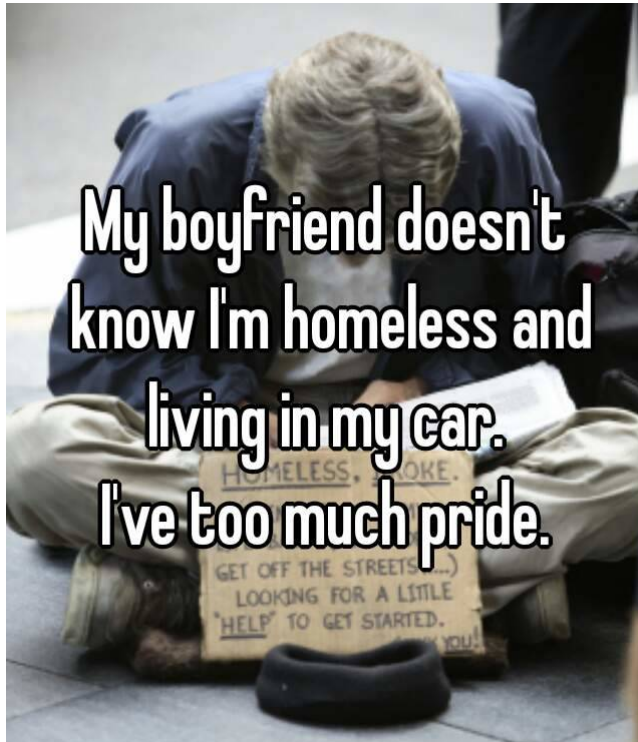


ATTENTION: ALL STUDENTS AT MONTEREY PENINSULA COLLEGE
