### **Student Financial Services**

Student Financial Services participated in the Monterey County Office of Education Parent Conference which was attended by 120 students and parents who were provided information about the financial aid process.

Student Financial Services also held an even titled, “Cash for College” this workshop was held at the Marina Education Center and had over 45 families attend on Saturday February 27 to complete their FAFSA applications.

### **Child Development Center**
