 - “IP” and “RD” are included in units attempted until final grades are assigned.
- 4. Complete at least 75% of the total units you have attempted:**
 - A class is considered complete only if a student earns a grade of “D” or better, or “Pass/Credit.”
 - Grades of “F,W, NP/NC, and/or I” are included in units attempted.
 - “IP” and “RD” are included in units attempted until final grades are assigned.
- 5. Complete your educational goal within the maximum time frame.**
 - You must complete your program of study within 90 attempted units.
