She is active at the state and national level, serving on the Rural Community College Alliance, CCLC's Legislative Advisory Council, Linked Learning Alliance, Council of Presidents

and Chancellors, Central Valley Higher Education Consortium, and the State Chancellor's Accreditation Workgroup II.
