Staffing

- Dean of Student Services- New position housed at Marina Campus with leadership responsibilities at the location.*
- Categorical Services Coordinator (CSC) II- New position full-time assigned to Dual Enrollment (includes Marina High School) and Dual Admissions (ACE with CSUMB)*
- Bilingual Categorical Services Coordinator (CSC) I- From 60% to 100%; assigned to Marina and PSTC campuses. (This position is cross-trained to deliver services related to admissions, orientation, assessment, financial aid, Veterans, scheduling building, and general student services)*

Services

- Student Services are available at the Education Center at Marina. Programs and services currently provided include:
 - Admissions
 - Assessment (to include testing accommodations)
 - Counseling (doubled availability to Monday-Thursday- both days and evening hours)*
 - Student Health Services (menu of self-serve resources as well as bi-monthly onsite services)*
 - Student Financial Services (doubled availability of services to weekly)*
 - Veterans Services (collaborates with Veterans Transition Center (VTC) in Marina)*
- Outreach-CSC I provides outreach services to Marina, Seaside and Salinas (upon request) communities.*
- Inreach-Classroom presentation made available to all classes at this location
- Reg. Days-Fall and Spring registration event occurs that include representative from all Student Services and many instructional programs
- Cash for College workshops
