VPAA - New Courses on Board Agenda 2/21

All courses on the agenda are approved to start fall 2018.

Two new business courses have been developed by Bruce Barrie, our newest Business faculty member. Mr. Barrie is focused on developing an Entrepreneurship emphasis within our Business program.

- **BUSI 46 Entrepreneurial Mindset:** This course will explore the impact of entrepreneurs throughout history and help students understand the traits that help entrepreneurs thrive. In this class students analyze, research, and create a basic business plan for an entrepreneurial undertaking of their choice.
- BUSI 68 Entrepreneurial Start-up Ventures: This course was developed as a
 capstone course for Business majors in the Entrepreneurship track. It is designed to
 engage teams of students to create a product to bring to market in the local community.

The two new International Studies courses are both foundational requirements of the Global Studies AA-T which is currently being developed by the Social Science Division.

- **INTL 1 Introduction to Global Studies:** This course is an introduction to the political, economic, cultural, and ecological facets of globalization.
- **INTL 2 Global Issues:** This course provides students with a historical and conceptual framework for analyzing issues facing the global community, include inequality, security, and environmental crisis.

The six new LETP courses are a part of our partnership with the South Bay Regional Public Safety Training Consortium.

LETP 203, **204**, **205**, **208**, **and 209** are courses required by POST for specialized investigators in the state of California:

- LETP 203 Robbery Investigations
- LETP 204 Investigation Core
- LETP 205 Officer-Involved Shooting and Death Investigation
- LETP 208 Child Abuse Investigations
- LETP 209 Sexual Assault Investigation

LETP 248 Surveillance Techniques: This course provides surveillance training for peace officers.
