- As part of MPC's goal to improve student success for our dual enrollment students, Student Services launched a series of workshops aimed at better preparing our AB 288 students this semester. This five workshop series provided much-needed course context, emphasized available resources, and empowered students to make more informed decisions about their education -- both in their MPC classroom, and beyond. Every CCAP student at Marina High school, a total of 120 students, completed these workshops. The students were well-behaved, engaged, and appreciative of the workshops and the materials shared and are able to start their MPC courses more confidently and better equipped. Topics in this first series included: Mattering vs. Marginalizing, College 101, Expectations in College vs. High School, Student Rights and Responsibilities, and Self-Advocacy and Communication. It is our goal to expand workshop offerings and to roll out these tailored workshops at each school site over the course of the semester.

The enrollment process for our AB 288 students also moved more smoothly this semester. We were able to start the process much earlier, courses were not restricted, and the high school communities -- including students -- are more readily grasping the three-step process required for participation in AB 288. Currently, 265 out of a projected 307 students are enrolled in AB 288

courses for spring, which is a significant improvement in comparison to our first semester.

In addition, we launched our MPC dual enrollment webpage, are rolling out a Dual Enrollment Ambassador program at Marina High, and are planning workshops and info nights at the middle schools in order to more effectively share MPC's AB 288 program with incoming high schoolers and their families.

Education Center at Marina

- The Education Center at Marina held one Early Start course in the evening, and we're ready for a robust Spring enrollment!
- Conducted an Outreach Session with the Veterans Transition Center (our neighbor).
- Our Bilingual Categorical Services Coordinator is in the process of being trained as a certifying official for Veterans Certification to serve students in Marina.
- Updated photos were taken of staff and facilities for the website.
