1. Enrollment Update:

This is an early look at enrollment data for spring 2018. The comparison is with end-of-term data for spring 2017.

Some points of note about the spring 2018 data:

- We are only in our first week of classes and "Census" day is not until the third Monday of the semester (February 5, 2017). Census day gives us a snap-shot of enrollment for semester-length classes.
- MPC has a large number of "Positive Attendance" classes. The FTES for all these classes are
 projections in the EMS program (Enrollment Management System) based on a three year trend
 (spring 2015 to spring 2018). The FTES data for these classes will not be final till the semester is
 over and student attendance is recorded in the Office of Admissions and Records.
- One-third of PSTC classes are "Positive Attendance" classes.
- We will continue to add enrollment for late start classes.
- South Bay FTES are not included in these data. The contract for 2017-18 is for 655 FTES.
- Enrollment attrition at the college is approximately 10% by the end of the semester.
- Fort Ord and Online each represent just over 14% of MPC FTES.
