WHAT DOES IT MEAN TO TRANSFER?

ASSOCIATE DEGREE VS BACHELOR DEGREE / 2 YEAR DEGREE VS 4 YEAR DEGREE

ASSOCIATE'S DEGREE PROGRAMS ARE 2-YEAR (OR 60 DEGREE APPLICABLE UNITS) PROGRAMS THAT MAY PREPARE STUDENTS FOR A CAREER OR TO TRANSFER INTO A **BACHELOR'S DEGREE** PROGRAM. **BACHELOR'S DEGREE** PROGRAMS ARE USUALLY 4-YEAR (OR 120 DEGREE APPLICABLE UNITS) COURSES OF STUDY AVAILABLE AT COLLEGES AND UNIVERSITIES THAT PROVIDE MORE ADVANCED STUDY IN A PARTICULAR MAJOR.

TRANSFERRING TO A UC

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

- 60 UC TRANSFERABLE UNITS
- 7 UC TRANSFERABLE GENERAL EDUCATION COURSES COMPLETED WITH A GRADE OF "C" OR BETTER THAT ARE COMPRISED OF:
 - 2 COURSES IN ENGLISH COMPOSITION
 - 1 COURSE IN MATHEMATICAL CONCEPTS/QUANTITATIVE REASONING
 - 4 ADDITIONAL COURSES FROM AT LEAST TWO OF THE FOLLOWING
 - DISCIPLINES: ARTS & HUMANITIES; SOCIAL/BEHAVIORAL SCIENCES; PHYSICAL/BIOLOGICAL SCIENCES
- **2.4 GPA FOR CALIFORNIA RESIDENTS**

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RECOMMENDED GUIDELINES

- 60 UC TRANSFERABLE UNITS
- LOWER DIVISION <u>MAJOR PREPARATION</u> COMPLETE
- IGETC OR CAMPUS SPECIFIC GENERAL EDUCATION COMPLETED (FOR LOW UNIT MAJORS) OR THE 7 REQUIRED COURSES
- 3.0+ GPA FOR CALIFORNIA RESIDENTS (MAY BE HIGHER FOR IMPACTED MAJORS)

MAJOR PREPARATION

• VERY IMPORTANT IN TRANSFERRING

OFTEN CONSIDERED MORE IMPORTANT THAN A HIGH GPA OR GENERAL EDUCATION COURSEWORK

TRANSFERRING TO A CSU

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

- 60 CSU TRANSFERABLE UNITS
- 30 GENERAL EDUCATION CSU TRANSFERABLE UNITS COMPLETED WITH GRADES OF "C" OR HIGHER WHICH MUST INCLUDE:
 - ALL OF AREA A (SPEECH, COMPOSITION, CRITICAL THINKING) AND AREA B4 (QUANTITATIVE REASONING - COLLEGE LEVEL MATH)
 - NOTE: MANY CSUS REQUIRE THESE FOUR COURSES BE COMPLETED BY SPRING FOR FALL TRANSFER, BY SUMMER FOR SPRING TRANSFER
- 2.0 GPA FOR CALIFORNIA RESIDENTS

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RECOMMENDED GUIDELINES

- 60 CSU TRANSFERABLE UNITS FOR FULL JUNIOR STANDING
- **39** CSU-TRANSFERABLE GENERAL EDUCATION UNITS COMPLETED AND **CERTIFIED**, OF WHICH 30 UNITS (INCLUDING ALL OF AREAS A & B4) MUST BE COMPLETED WITH A "C" OR HIGHER
- LOWER DIVISION MAJOR PREPARATION DONE
- 2.5+ GPA (IMPACTED MAJORS AND POPULAR CAMPUSES MAY USE ADDITIONAL "SELECTION CRITERIA", INCLUDING A HIGHER GPA AND SPECIFIC PREPARATION.]

WHAT IS IMPACTION?

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- IMPACTION HAPPENS WHEN THE NUMBER OF APPLICATIONS RECEIVED FROM QUALIFIED APPLICANTS IS GREATER THAN THE NUMBER OF AVAILABLE SPACES.
- AN ENTIRE CAMPUS MAY BE IMPACTED, SPECIFIC MAJORS MAY BE IMPACTED, OR BOTH, DEPENDING ON THE CAMPUS.
- IN THE CASE OF IMPACTION, A CSU CAMPUS IS ALLOWED TO USE ADDITIONAL CRITERIA TO SCREEN APPLICATIONS.
- CAMPUSES WITHOUT THE IMPACTION DESIGNATION AT THE PROGRAM OR CAMPUS LEVEL ARE OPEN TO ALL CSU ELIGIBLE APPLICANTS.

ASSOCIATE DEGREES FOR TRANSFER

- THE CALIFORNIA COMMUNITY COLLEGES (CCC) ASSOCIATE IN ART FOR TRANSFER (AA-T) AND THE ASSOCIATE IN SCIENCE FOR TRANSFER (AS-T) DEGREES ARE TWO-YEAR ASSOCIATE DEGREES THAT ARE FULLY TRANSFERABLE TO THE CSU AND ARE NO MORE THAN 60 SEMESTER UNITS OR 90 QUARTER UNITS.
- WITH THESE ASSOCIATE DEGREES FOR TRANSFER (ADT) SOMETIMES CALLED A <u>DEGREE WITH A GUARANTEE</u> STUDENTS WHO MEET THE CSU'S MINIMUM ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS ARE GUARANTEED PRIORITY ADMISSION TO A CSU CAMPUS, THOUGH NOT NECESSARILY TO A PARTICULAR CAMPUS OR MAJOR.
- WITH AN ADT YOU WILL BE ABLE TO EARN TWO DEGREES YOUR ASSOCIATE'S DEGREE ANDYOUR BACHELOR'S DEGREE WITH ONLY 120 UNITS IF YOU TRANSFER INTO A PROGRAM AT THE CSU THAT'S SIMILAR TO THE ONE IN WHICH YOU EARNED YOUR ASSOCIATE'S AT A CALIFORNIA COMMUNITY COLLEGE.
- IF YOU'RE ALREADY ENROLLED AT A CALIFORNIA COMMUNITY COLLEGE OR THINKING OF APPLYING TO ONE, VISIT THE COLLEGE'S TRANSFER CENTER OR TALK TO A COUNSELOR TO <u>EXPLORE AVAILABLE AA-T AND AS-T DEGREES</u> AND DEVELOP A PLAN THAT WILL ALLOW YOU TO TRANSFER TO THE CSU AS PART OF THE ADT PROGRAM.

WHEN DO I APPLY TO TRANSFER?

- UC AND CSU CAMPUSES: NOVEMBER 30 FOR THE NEXT FALL TERM
 - SPRING AND WINTER TRANSFER: MEET WITH A COUNSELOR TO DISCUSS
- PRIVATE AND OUT OF STATE UNIVERSITIES: DEADLINES VARY

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 FOR HELP ON APPLYING TO PRIVATE AND OUT OF STATE SCHOOLS, MAKE AN APPOINTMENT WITH YOUR COUNSELOR OR VISIT THE CAREER AND TRANSFER CENTER


- FINANCIAL AID CALCULATORS OR NET PRICE CALCULATORS
