MPC Security will be coordinating the drill, Monterey Police and Fire Department will be participating on campus, volunteers will be acting as victims.

PREPARING FOR A LOCKDOWN

STAY WHERE YOU ARE

- Do not go outdoors
- Close and lock doors, barricade them if possible
- Silence your phones!
- Do not open the doors for ANYONE!
- If you are not inside a building, prepare to **RUN, HIDE, FIGHT**
- Remain where you are until you are given an official **“ALL CLEAR”**
