Walk-in Clinic

TREATMENT SERVICES

- Sore throats, earaches, coughs, sinus issues
- Minor infections including: wound, skin, and urinary
- Basic wound care
- Diabetes: Checking blood sugar, oral medications for blood sugar control, education
- High blood pressure:Blood pressure checks, oral medications

Staffed by a nurse practitioner, other clinicians, and volunteers. The mobile clinic offers two exam rooms.

The clinic does not carry or prescribe painkillers, sedatives, sleeping pills, or controlled medications (such as opioids).
