Scholarship Amount - \$500 a year

May be renewed on a yearly basis (until completion of California K-12 Credential) with verification of enrollment for 12 or more units per semester and a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher.

Eligibility

- 1. Applicant must be a woman studying to be a K-12 teacher in California
- 2. Applicant has completed 30 units of college work with a GPA of 3.0 or better.

Selection Criteria

- Strong interest in entering the field of education
- Evidence of scholastic accomplishment

Requirements

- 1. Completed application
- 2. Transcript of college work
- 3. Two letters of recommendation from people familiar with your interest and/or experience in education
- 4. Statement of 1-2 pages telling why you are interested in becoming a teacher. Include hands-on teaching experiences as well as other factors influencing your choice.
