Our college's methodology for the Institution-set Standards is the 5-year mean (using the most recent 5 years of data) minus the average standard deviation for the most recent 5 years. We use the same methodology for all of the student achievement metrics.

Our college set stretch goals for successful course completion rates through the IEPI goal-setting process. We did not establish stretch goals for any of the other student achievement metrics in this report.

The three most recent years for which we have data for job placement rates (question 18) are 2014-15, 2015-16, and 2016-17; these are the years we reported in the columns FY 15/16, FY 16/17, and FY 17/18, respectively. It should also be noted that the data source for job placement rates relies on a match with the California Employment Development Department (CA EDD) Unemployment Insurance (UI) database which only includes individuals who are eligible for unemployment insurance. This may explain the low rates for some programs such as Child Development, since many of our graduates work for in-home providers that do not offer that benefit.

The data included in this report are certified as a complete and accurate representation of the reporting institution.

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
