

Fall Applications UC Transfer Checklist

August/September

- Meet with your counselor to finalize transfer admission eligibility
- Gather transcripts from all colleges attended (unofficial is fine)
- Draft responses to Personal Insight Questions
- Submit **UC TAG** application between **September 1-30**
- Attend transfer workshops (UC Personal Insight Questions and UC TAG)

October

- Apply for Financial Aid (priority deadline is March 2, but the sooner the better)
 - o FAFSA www.fafsa.gov or California Dream Act caldreamact.org
- Have personal statements reviewed in the English Study Skills Center, by your counselor, or in the Career & Transfer Resource Center
- Attend transfer workshops
- Visit campus specific Preview Days & take campus tours.
- Attend Transfer Day and ask your questions to university and college representatives directly

November

- Application filing period for Fall term to UC campuses is November 1-30. Apply at UC Apply Online
- Attend transfer workshops
- Visit campus specific Preview Days & take campus tours.
- Submit admissions applications. Check your email for a confirmation letter after applying.

December

- Research housing and any other resources or services you need
- Research scholarship opportunities for the next academic year
- Develop a timeline reflecting important deadlines from present to entering the university

January

- Research/Apply for scholarships, housing, etc.
- Complete the Transfer Academic Update: update your application by January 31st with your Fall semester grades
 - o Establish your student account
 - o Log in and update your grades
 - o Be sure to check your student accounts and email regularly. Respond to any and all requests from the UC campuses to which you applied.
 - o UC Berkeley requires its own specific update as well as the general UC Transfer Academic Update

February/March

- Submit documents as requested
- Apply for Financial Aid (priority deadline is March 2)
 - o FAFSA www.fafsa.gov or California Dream Act caldreamact.org
- Apply for Monterey Peninsula College graduation
 - o Not sure if you are eligible to earn a degree? Make an appointment with your counselor
 - o Receiving an Associate's Degree for Transfer? Your deadline to apply for graduation will be sooner. Check MPC's Important Dates and Deadlines.
- Research/Apply for scholarships, housing, etc.

April/May

- Research/Apply for scholarships, housing, etc.
- Review Financial Aid Award Offer

June/July

- Submit Statement of Intent to Register (SIR) by June 1st
- Request General Education Certification through MPC's Admissions and Records
- Request official transcripts from each college attended (high school if necessary) by July 1st
- Send other documents such as AP, IB, and TOEFL scores as necessary or requested by the UC campuses by July 15th
- Sign up for a transfer student orientation (bring unofficial transcripts)
- Register for classes (usually done at orientation)
- Submit other forms (immunization records, residency forms, etc.) as requested by university
