### **Program Overview**

#### **Job Outlook**

Mastering English can result in pay 25% to 40% higher than for those with limited English proficiency. In addition, English has a reputation for being difficult to learn, so graduates who have mastered the language have demonstrated the ability to overcome a challenge and learn a new skill.
