# Monterey Peninsula College 2021-2022 Parent (PLUS) Loan for Undergraduate Student Application

## **Eligibility**

To qualify for Federal Parent PLUS Loan you must:

- ⇒ Cannot be in default on any type of Federal Loan.
- ⇒ Be a U.S. citizen or eligible non-citizen.
- ⇒ Apply for an FSA ID at <a href="https://studentaid.ed.gov/sa/fafsa/filling-out/fsaid.">https://studentaid.ed.gov/sa/fafsa/filling-out/fsaid.</a>
- ⇒ Student completes the 2021-2022 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at: https://fafsa.ed.gov
- ⇒ Pass a credit check conducted by the loan servicing agency. A Parent PLUS loan applicant who is determined to have an adverse credit history <u>may</u> receive the loan if he or she obtains a co-signer for the loan who passes the credit check.

### Application Process

- 1. Submit a 2021-2022 Parent PLUS Loan Application to the MPC Student Financial Services Office.
- 2. Go to <a href="https://studentaid.gov/">https://studentaid.gov/</a> Log In=> "Apply for Aid" => "Apply for a Parent PLUS Loan" => "I am a Parent of an Undergraduate Student => START Follow the instructions provided.
- 3. Go to <a href="https://studentaid.gov/">https://studentaid.gov/</a> Click on the "Complete Aid Process" => "MPN for Parents" => "PLUS MPN for Par
- 4. The interest rate for the 2021-2022 year is 6.28%.
- An origination fee of 4.228% will be deducted from each disbursement.

## **PLUS MPN for Parents**

The *Master Promissory Note* (MPN) is a legal document in which you promise to repay your loan(s) and any accrued interest and fees to the U.S. Department of Education. It also explains the terms and conditions of your loan(s).

You may receive more than one loan under an MPN over a period of up to 10 years to pay for your child's educational costs, as long as the school is authorized to use the MPN in this way and chooses to do so.

Your child's school will tell you which loans, if any, you are eligible to receive.

Parents must be logged in with their own account username and password (FSA ID) to submit.
