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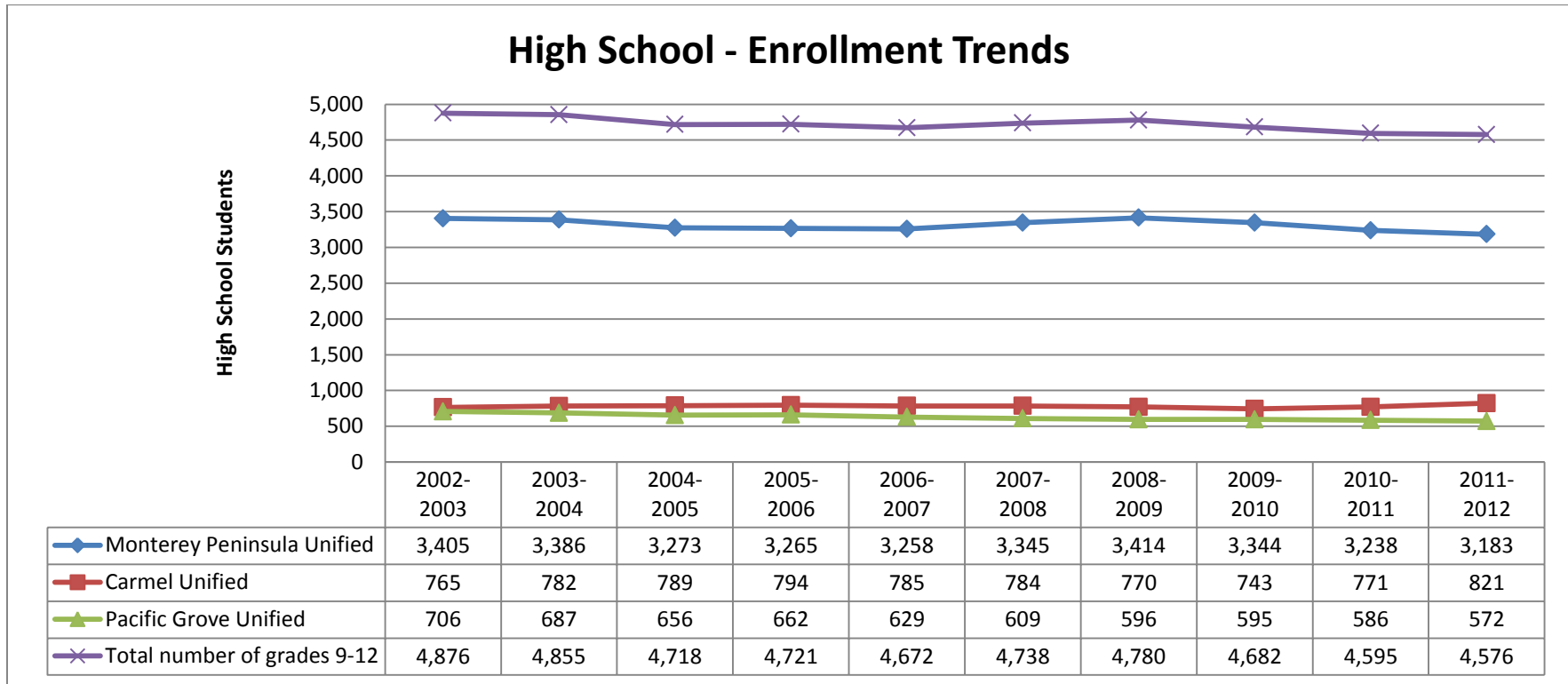
K-12 Enrollments

High School Enrollments

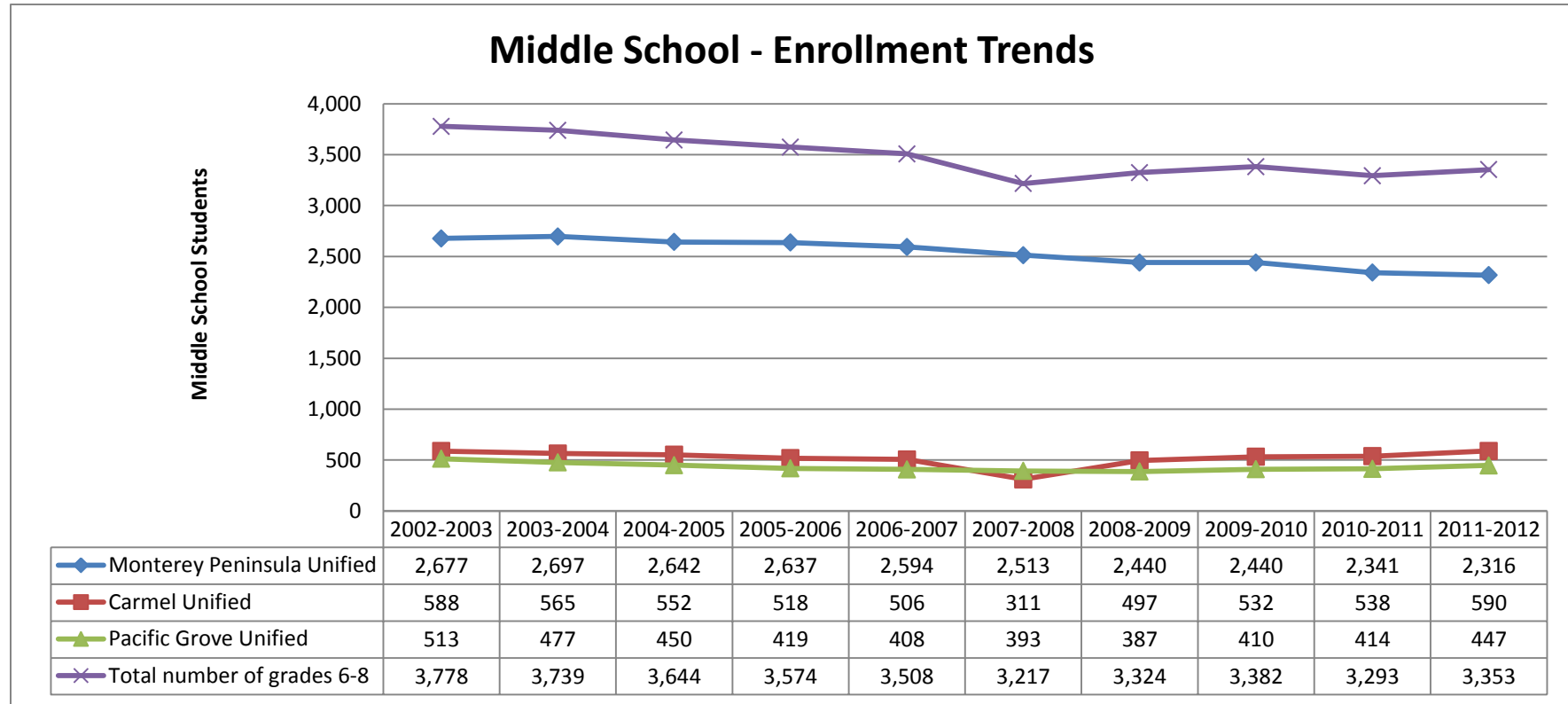
The graph illustrates that the total number of public grade 9-12 high school enrollments in MPC’s district declined about -6% from ten years ago. Monterey Peninsula Unified declined about -7%; Carmel Unified increased about +7%; and Pacific Grove Unified declined about -19%.

Middle School Enrollments

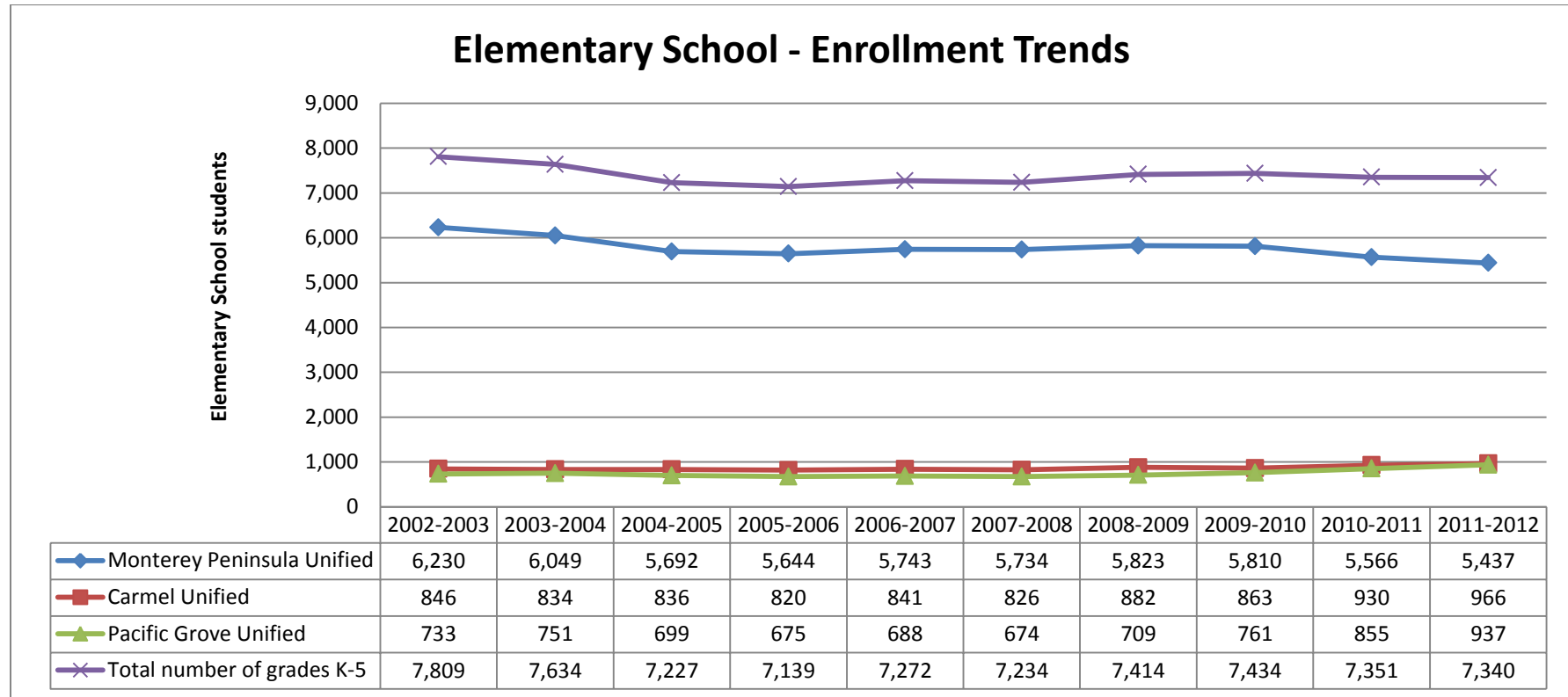
The graph illustrates that the total number of public grade 6-8 middle school enrollments in MPC’s district declined about -11% from ten years ago. Monterey Peninsula Unified declined about -13%; Carmel Unified was about the same number; and Pacific Grove Unified declined with about -13%.

Elementary School Enrollments

The graph illustrates that the total number of public grade K-5 elementary school enrollments in MPC’s district declined about -6% from ten years ago. Monterey Peninsula Unified declined about -13%; Carmel Unified increased about +14%; and Pacific Grove Unified increased about +28%.

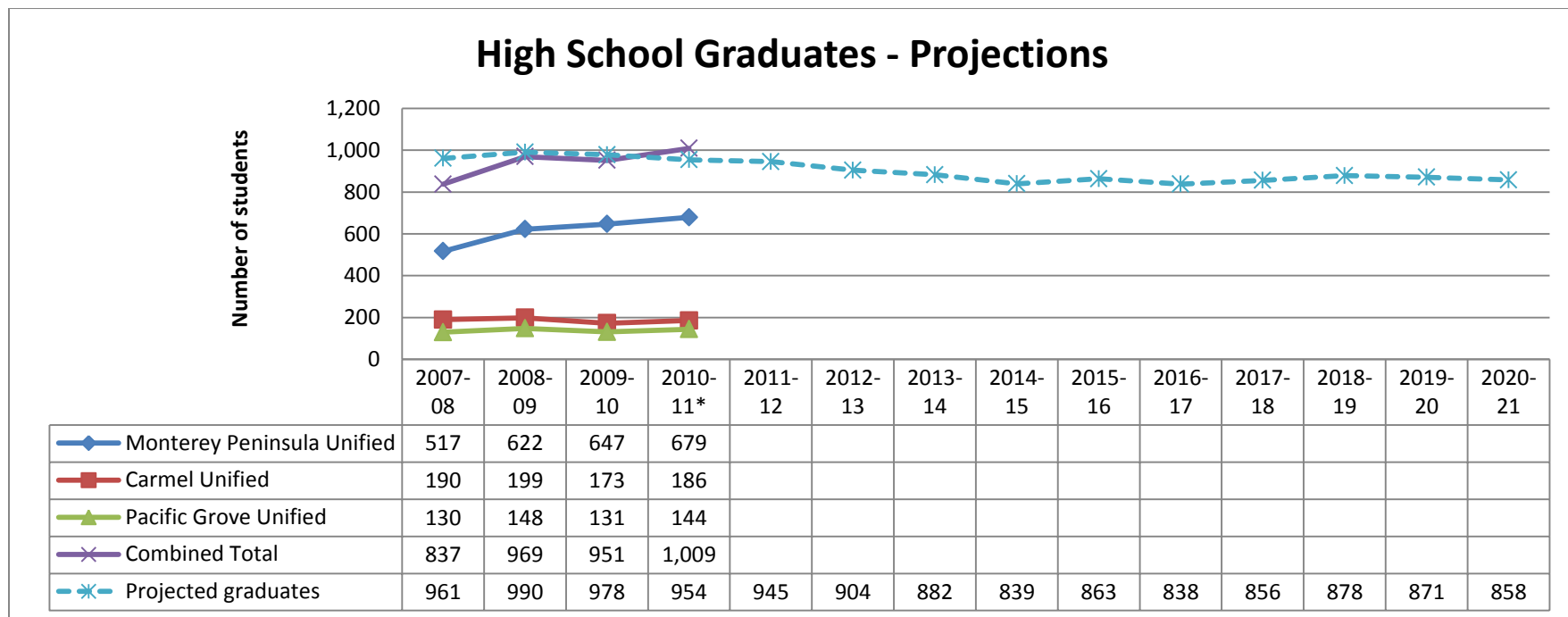

High School Graduates - Projections

The California Department of Finance provides an unofficial projection of the aggregated number of graduates for each California Community College district. The graduation projections provided in 2008 are quite close to the actual graduation numbers in 2007-08 to 2010-11. In March 2012, the California Department of Finance provided MPC with new district projections for 2011-12 out to 2020-21.

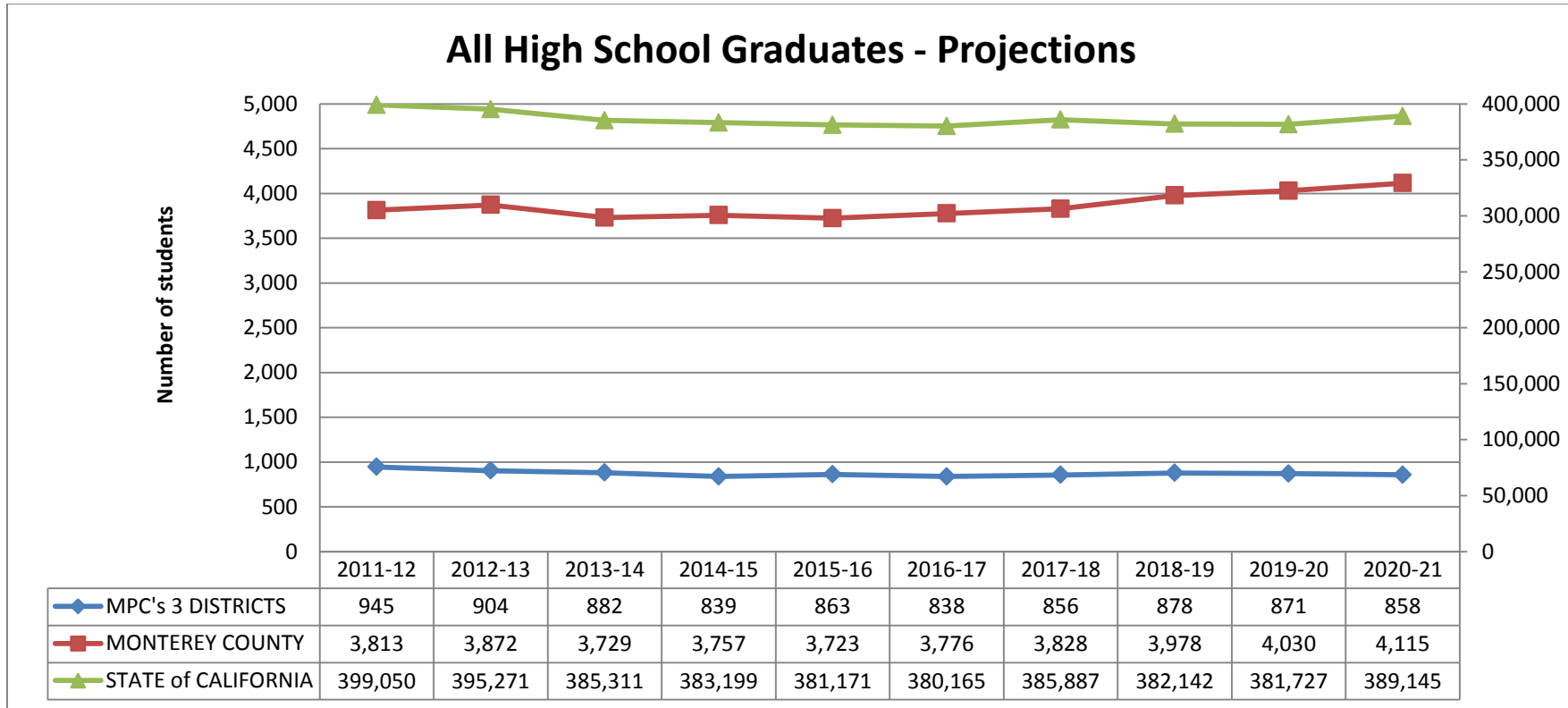

All High School Graduates - Projections

The graph below shows high school graduation projections for the three K-12 districts in our district combined, Monterey County, and the State of California. The graph illustrates over the next 10 years the high school graduates in our local public schools is projected to decline about -9%; Monterey County to increase about +8%; the State of California to decline about -2%.
