5610

AP 5610 Voter Registration

A good faith effort shall be made to encourage voter registration to each eligible student enrolled in a degree or certificate program and physically in attendance at the District.

- Mail-in voter registration forms shall be made widely available to students at the District.
- Distribute, in conjunction with the Secretary of State, campus-wide emails to all students with specified voting and election-related dates and information, and to include specified dates on all print and academic calendars.
- To post on social media reminders to students of specified voter-related dates and information.
- An active link to the California Secretary of State's voter registration web page or site shall be provided in the student portal to allow students to register to vote during the enrollment process.
- The District designee for the California Secretary of State to contact for purposes of distribution of voter registration cards shall be the Student Activities Coordinator who also serves as the Civic and Voter Empowerment Coordinator.
