I am an orphan. Check this box only if: you had no living parent (biological or adoptive) at any time since the age of 13 − even if you are now adopted. Submit: Copy of death certificate for each of your parents. I was in foster care. State: Check this box only if: you were in foster care at any time since the age of 13 − even if you are no longer in foster care as of today. Submit: Copy of court orders, or a letter from your caseworker to verify your status. I am/was a dependent or ward of the court. Check this box only if: you are/were a dependent or ward of the court as of today. Submit: Copy of court's decision or other documentation to verify your status. Note: for Federal Student Aid purposes, someone who is/was a ward of the court due to incarceration does not qualify. I made an error on my FAFSA. Check this box only if you are not and have never been: an orphan a dependent or ward of the court or, in foster care Instructions: if you checked I made an error on my FAFSA, you must correct the information on your aid application to answer No to the question about being an orphan, ward of court or in foster care and provide your parent(s) information and signature.
