

Out of State Prepared Checklist Central Coast Teach Up - Monterey Peninsula College



Elementary Education teachers must earn a Multiple Subject Teaching Credential, certifying educators to teach all subjects in self-contained TK-12 classrooms. The first step to becoming a certified teacher is to earn a five-year Preliminary Credential. Candidates who are prepared outside of the United States can complete the requirements below to earn their Preliminary Credential. This route requires candidates to apply directly to the Commission on Teaching Credentialing (CTC). A series of minimum requirements must be completed before candidates are awarded their Preliminary Credential. There are also suggested requirements that may be added to your application. REQUIREMENTS CHECKLIST:	
Application Form	Candidates must submit completed applications using forms 41-4.
Official Transcripts	Official transcripts must be submitted to verify bachelor's degree and any additional higher degrees.
Out of State License	A copy of your professional-level license authorizing elementary school teaching must be submitted. Submit a copy of both sides of the document if the back has licensing information or authorizations.
Fingerprinting	Please refer to the CTC's website for specific fingerprinting requirements.
