Secondary Education teachers earn a Single Subject Teaching Credential, certifying educators to teach a specific subject in middle or high school classrooms. The first step to becoming a certified teacher is to earn a five-year Preliminary Credential. The Early Completion Intern Option allows candidates in an intern program with the required skills to challenge the coursework portion of a Credential Program. <input type="checkbox"/> National Evaluation Series Assessment of Professional Knowledge (NES APK)	<p>Candidates must pass the NES APK. Single Subject Credential candidates must pass the Assessment of Professional Knowledge: Secondary exam (Test code 052). Visit the NES website for more information.</p>
<input type="checkbox"/> Initial Teaching Performance Assessment	<p>To be eligible for the ECO route, candidates MUST pass the initial TPA on the first try. This performance-based exam is completed while in a Teacher Preparation Program. Speak to your advisor about which exam you need to complete and what support is offered. Please keep in mind that this is an extensive exam that requires planning, editing, and evaluation before submitting. For more information, please contact our program coordinator.</p> <p>If your Teacher Preparation Program uses the CaITPA, you will have to pass Cycle 1 to satisfy this requirement.</p> <p>If your Teacher Preparation Program uses the edTPA, you will have to pass Task 1 to satisfy this requirement.</p>

<input type="checkbox"/> Reading Instruction Competence Assessment (RICA)	Satisfied by <u>one</u> of the following options: <input type="checkbox"/> Written Examination <input type="checkbox"/> Video Examination
<input type="checkbox"/> Live Scan to the CTC	Fingerprinting must be completed if it has not been completed before and submitted to the CTC. Please download and complete form 41-LS to complete this requirement.
<input type="checkbox"/> Computer Education	Complete foundational computer education coursework. The CTC identifies that the course work must include "general and specialized skills in the use of computers in educational settings."
<input type="checkbox"/> Employment Offer	Candidates must have an employment offer to be eligible for the ECO route. Candidates must also be in a district or university intern program. The program sponsor must submit an application to the CTC on behalf of the candidate.
<input type="checkbox"/> Formal Recommendation	Upon completion of the credential program and the requirements listed above, candidates will apply to the CTC for their Preliminary Credential with the recommendation of the credential program in attendance. More information will be provided while nearing the end of your credential program.
