

Peace Corps Teaching Experience Route Checklist

Secondary Education teachers must earn a Multiple Subject Teaching Credential, certifying educators to teach all subjects in self-contained TK-12 classrooms. The first step to becoming a certified teacher is to earn a five-year Preliminary Credential. Individuals with Peace Corps Teaching Experience can use their experience in place of a Teacher Preparation Program. This route requires candidates who have "certification by the director of the Peace Corps of the United States or the Peace Corps County Director that the applicant has satisfactorily completed at least 18 months in a Peace Corps assignment in a foreign country, during which time 50 percent or more of their duties consisted of classroom teaching of resident children of the foreign country" to apply directly to the Commission on Teaching Credentialing (CTC).
