WHAT ARE SCHOLARSHIPS?

MPC SCHOLARSHIPS



- There are over 90 named scholarships for different purposes
- One application gives you access to \$400,000 or 300 awards
- Last year 90% of applicants received an award
- Awards range from \$100 \$30,000!
- An average award is \$1500

- Recipients are celebrated at an award ceremony in May
- Other opportunities are sometimes offered to our scholars like internships and networking!

 This list is not exhaustive. If you meet the criteria to the left then <u>YOU ARE</u> <u>ELIGIBLE!</u>




NEW SCHOLARSHIPS IN 2023

 - For transfer students, preferably those who have their sights set on UCLA






It's easier than you think.

AWARDSPRING

- Log in and register an account at mpc.awardspring.com
- If you registered in the past, you still have an account!
 You can log on with your same password or click
 "Forgot Password" to reset it.

LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION

YOU MUST SUBMIT 2 LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATI ON. YOU MAY SUBMIT A MAX OF 4. ONE SHOULD BE FROM A **CURRENT OR** RECENT INSTRUCTOR.

PROVIDE AT LEAST 2-3 WEEKS NOTICE TO YOUR RECOMMENDER. ASK THEM FACE TO FACE FIRST IF POSSIBLE - IF NOT THEN ASK BY EMAIL OR PHONE. THEN SEND **AWARDSPRING** REQUEST.

WHEN YOU SEND
THE AWARDSPRING
REQUEST,
CUSTOMIZE THE
MESSAGE BOX.
ENTER IN YOUR
GOALS AND
ACCOMPLISHMENTS.

FOLLOW-UP ON RECOMMENDATIONS . IT IS YOU **RESPONISIBILITY TO** MAKE SURE THAT THEY SHOW AS COMPLETE. IN YOUR AWARDSPRING. **AFTER YOU SUBMIT** YOUR APP, YOU CAN STILL CHECK AND MAKE CHANGES.

PERSONAL STATEMENT

This question is required

Please write a 500 word personal statement telling us about yourself and describing your educational journey and career aspirations. You may also wish to describe challenges and accomplishments along the way, how your past has influenced you, or how receiving a scholarship would help you reach your goals.

Pick one of the following to answer:

- The lessons we take from the obstacles we encounter can be fundamental to later success. Recount a time when you faced a challenge, setback, or failure. How did it affect you, and what did you learn from the experience?
- Reflect on something that someone has done for you that has made you happy or thankful in a surprising way. How has this gratitude affected or motivated you in a positive manner?
- Describe a topic, idea, or concept you find particularly engaging or feel passionately about. Why does it captivate or inspire you? How do you plan to incorporate this into your future learning, career path, or life in general?

TRANSCRIPTS

- You do not need to upload MPC transcripts.
- If you are in High School, it is recommended that you upload High School transcripts.
- If you have attended other colleges, please upload those transcripts.

OTHER IMPORTANT THINGS


- The application saves dynamically.
- "Submit" as soon as you can continue to edit until March 5th.
- There will be follow-up essays
 AFTER you submit for special scholarship opportunities.



DEADLINE TO SUBMIT: MARCH 5TH

Submit early - you can continue to make edits up until March 5th, but if you do not hit submit, your application will not be considered. We will not score your application until March 6th!

Once you submit, you will have follow-up essays available. While not required, they dramatically increase your odds of winning a scholarship.


