## NAWIC Founders Scholarship Foundation (NFSF)

The National Association of Women in Construction (NAWIC) Founders' Scholarship Foundation (NFSF) assists in providing the construction industry with trained employees through higher education.

- The construction industry encompasses almost every professional discipline, including trades, project management, administrative, legal, financial, insurance, and business owner.
- Award amounts range from \$500 to \$2,000.
- Deadline is **February 28th** for the following academic year.

### CONSTRUCTION TRADES

- Applicant must be currently enrolled in a construction-related training program which is approved by the Bureau of Apprenticeship Training, community college, technical school or equivalent.
- Applicant must be obtaining training in a construction-related craft or trade.

### UNDERGRADUATE

- Applicant must be currently enrolled in a construction-related degree program at a school in the United States and must have a least one term remaining in a course of study leading to a degree or an associate degree in a construction-related field. High school seniors and those pursuing graduate degrees are not eligible.
- Applicant must be enrolled full-time. With a cumulative GPA or 3.0 or higher to be considered for awards.
