5. Athletics Update (Wendy Bates)
 - Wendy shared a few updates about our Athletics Department. In full swing this week are men's and women's Track, also Softball, and men's and women's basketball. Tennis and Beach Volleyball are competing now.
 - One not very popular update is that we are suspending intercollegiate Golf for this semester, but we are hoping to bring it back soon. We have no golf classes available this semester. We are working on solving this issue. We have not been

able to secure a course. In addition, there are no conferences for us to play, so the travel is far and costly.

- Last night we had a celebration of equity in sports (Title IX celebration) at what was supposed to be a double header men and women basketball games, but Gavilan men had to postpone until Monday. We had a nice display, that is available for you to see here in this room. It was a great event; our women's team beat Gavilan soundly and it was good time all the way around.

7. Discuss Fundraising Plans to Support Athletics Academics (Beccie Michael)

- The conversation started with the naming of the space that focuses on student athletes' academic success. On the second page of this document, there are ideas for the uses of this space and some fundraising notes.
- Ideas to promote the space were discussed, including students sharing short videos, display of students' academic achievements, large pictures of students in action and so forth.
- The committee discussed different ideas of how to fundraise to support the space.
- Beccie brought up a few points to promote the space, including social media cross pollination with all athletics social media and the MPC Foundation generating the content and messages and vice versa.
- The committee discussed wanting to have a greater presence at home sport events. It would be great to have some promotional material to share at these events.
- The committee continued discussing other possibilities to promote the space and how effective it will be if we make students part of the fundraising.
