Prepared statement offered by John Taylor Finnell: "Over the last 13 months, the History Department has worked with the Gender and Women's Studies Department in an attempt to resolve conflict over the cross listed course: HIST/GWOS 12.

After 42 emails (that I could find), a written and negotiated agreement on how the course would be scheduled (which GWOS backed out of two weeks later), 3 meetings totaling over 6 hours of discussion with mediators such as the Social Science Division Chair (Lauren Blanchard), 2 Deans (Diane Boynton and Jeannie Kim), the VP of Academic Affairs (Jon Knolle), and the Head of the Curriculum Advisory Committee (Gamble Madsen) the History Department has determined that HIST/GWOS 12 can no longer be cross listed.

Using the "Guidelines for cross-listing/cross-referencing MPC courses" document, the History Department has followed guidelines set forth by CAC under the "in case of a disagreement" section and would now like to finalize this cross listing separation. Due to conflict over course scheduling and disciplinary issues, it is in the best interest of the students in the History Department that this course be un-cross listed. The History Department appreciates your time and cooperation with this separation as it will allow this department to better serve our students."
