

Student Financial Services Unaccompanied Homeless Youth Verification Form

On your FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) or California Dream Act Application you indicate that at any time on or after July 1, 2023 you are/were an unaccompanied youth who is homeless or self-supporting and at risk of being homeless. Please have this form completed by the authorizing individual and submit along with any required documentation to the Financial Aid Office. **You must renew your status every academic year, see reverse for renewal option.**

Homeless means lacking fixed, regular, and adequate housing. You may be homeless if you are living in shelters, parks, motels, hotels, public spaces, camping grounds, cars, abandoned buildings, or temporarily living with other people because you have nowhere else to go. Also, if you are living in any of these situations and fleeing an abusive parent, you may be considered homeless even if your parent would otherwise provide a place to live. Unaccompanied means you are not living in the physical custody of your parent or guardian.
C. Letter of Verification – Check one
