2. Go to www.irs.gov and click on the "Get your tax record" link to get a copy online or request by mail.
3. Get transcripts by mail with the 4506-T form.

Be aware that this process can take up to 10 business days for the transcripts to arrive which will delay the student's awarding process.

*You will need the Social Security Number (SSN) or Individual Taxpayer Identification Number (ITIN), date of birth and the address on file with the IRS (normally this will be the address used when the 2022 IRS tax return was filed.)
