Duties and Responsibilities

The tasks may include but are not limited to assisting in monitoring photographic chemistry, assisting students in photographic processes, aiding students who may have an accessibility issue so the faculty may be more present for all students, assisting faculty in darkroom organization, assisting faculty in equipment testing for student use, and assisting in basic maintenance of darkroom equipment, assisting students in digital darkroom processes, monitoring ink levels on printers and basic maintenance of scanners and printers that are specific to photography—assisting students in use of SLR and DSLR cameras, assisting in maintaining SLR cameras for student checkout.

Eligibility Criteria

Student must have completed or be currently enrolled in ARTP 11A or equivalent course work at another college with a passing grade.

Minimum Requirements
