We promote positive relationships for children and adults to help children feel good about them. We strive to establish and maintain a strong relationship with each family as well.

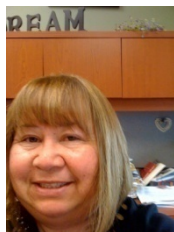
