- ⇒ Student completes the 2014-15 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at www.fafsa.gov.
- ⇒ Pass a credit check conducted by the loan servicing agency. A PLUS applicant who is determined to have an adverse credit history may receive the loan if he or she obtains a co-signer for the loan who passes the credit check.

Application Process

- 1. Submit a 2014-15PLUS Loan Application to the MPC Student Financial Services Office.
- **2.** Go to: <u>StudentLoans.gov</u> Click on "Request a Direct PLUS Loan" and "Complete a MPN". Following the instructions provided on the website.
- 3. Interest for the 2014/2015 academic year 7.21%. A 4.288% origination fee will be deducted.
