

# Monterey Peninsula College 2014-2015 Parent Loan for Undergraduate Student (PLUS) Application

## Eligibility

To apply for a Federal PLUS Loan you must:

- ⇒ Not be in default on any type of federal loan.
- ⇒ Be a U.S. citizen or eligible non-citizen.
- ⇒ Parent must apply for a Federal Student Aid Pin at [www.pin.ed.gov](http://www.pin.ed.gov).
- ⇒ Student completes the 2014-15 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at [www.fafsa.gov](http://www.fafsa.gov).
- ⇒ Pass a credit check conducted by the loan servicing agency. A PLUS applicant who is determined to have an adverse credit history may receive the loan if he or she obtains a co-signer for the loan who passes the credit check.

## Application Process

1. Submit a 2014-15PLUS Loan Application to the MPC Student Financial Services Office.
2. Go to: [StudentLoans.gov](http://StudentLoans.gov) Click on “Request a Direct PLUS Loan” and “Complete a MPN”. Following the instructions provided on the website.
3. Interest for the 2014/2015 academic year 7.21%. A 4.288% origination fee will be deducted.
