

Secondary/Postsecondary Articulation Agreement

Statement of Intent

This agreement enables students to receive college credit for completion of courses at the secondary level or the Regional Occupational Program that are comparable to courses offered at Monterey Peninsula College (MPC). The granting of college credit is based on the achievement of student learning objectives through a course, or a sequence of courses, as defined Credit by Proficiency Examination (Attachment 1) that specifies the conditions of the articulation agreement.

Terms of the Agreement

This agreement between MPC and shall remain in force for an indefinite period of time but shall be reviewed for possible revisions at the completion of each school year. This review will include an examination of up-to-date course outlines and a discussion of current teaching methodologies. Either party of the agreement may terminate this agreement at the close of any school year by notice in writing to the President/Superintendent of the other institution.

Course being Articulated

The agrees to certify via the Credit by Proficiency Exam form, those students who have successfully completed student learning objectives from
